Cost: JH - \$85 CS - \$70 (As always, CS students are required to also be enrolled in JH.)

We enjoyed the fall semester plan, which allowed us to meet safely. We will use the same plan for the spring 2021 semester.

Location:

538 Maury Hill St., Spring Hill. This is the home of Mike and Stephanie Fennema (pastor of Spring Hill Presbyterian Church), where there is a designated building we use for rehearsals

Building Details:

- 1400 square feet, providing 39 person capacity with 6' distancing
- Ductless air conditioning system; woodburning stove for heating
- Garage doors on front and back that can be opened in nice weather to provide cross ventilation
- There is one bathroom in the building. Since students are not on site for long periods, bathroom use will hopefully be minimal.
- Plastic, folding chairs available. These will be pre-sanitized and post-sanitized for the safety of everyone, using disinfectant (3% peroxide solution and/or Clorox wipes).

Schedule:

- Tuesdays, February 2 – May 11
- Chamber Singers meet every week, 9:30-10:30.
- Joyful Harmony meets in two groups, Mens' and Womens' choirs alternating every other week, 11:00-12:00.

Plan A

Attending rehearsals live via Zoom will continue to be an option for those students whose families are not comfortable with meeting in person. Consistent and faithful attendance (unless ill) is expected whether in person or over Zoom per Section 6 of the NN Handbook.

Plan B

We were blessed in the fall to never have to go to this plan. But here it is just in case: If we have a need to quarantine due to a positive COVID diagnosis among our singers, we will continue rehearsals over Zoom for one week and then resume in-person the following week provided everything is deemed safe. If, after one Zoom rehearsal, we are still unable to meet in person for whatever reason, rehearsals will be cancelled until it is safe to return to live rehearsals and refunds will be issued or credited to spring semester.

Arrival and Departure Procedures:

- No parents or siblings on site during class. We will provide a list of places in the surrounding area to wait if parents would like to inquire. This is a “drop-off” model class.
- Students should plan to arrive 10 min prior to the start of class to allow proper time for a more methodical check-in procedure. JH students should NOT enter any sooner than 10:50 to allow time for CS students to depart at 10:30 followed by sanitization of surfaces.
- There is one door, so it’s important to promptly exit when rehearsal is finished and wait to enter until 10 minutes prior to start time.
- When students sign in upon arrival (with their own pen/pencil), they are confirming absence of symptoms, no close contact with COVID-19, etc. (Click here to see the sign in form.) They will also be required to sanitize their hands before entering the class.
- Social distanced seating/standing will be marked on the floor.
- All singers are required to wear a face shield. Be watching for an email from Mrs. Chapman for a link to purchase the correct shield.
- Chairs will be sanitized with Clorox wipes after each class (student leadership team)
