We enjoyed the fall semester plan, which allowed us to meet safely. We will use the same plan for the spring 2021 semester.

### **Location:**

538 Maury Hill St., Spring Hill. This is the home of Mike and Stephanie Fennema (pastor of Spring Hill Presbyterian Church), where there is a designated building that we will be reserving for class use.

### **Building Details:**

- 1400 square feet, providing 39 person capacity with 6' distancing. (Theory class enrollment is expected to be 5 students or less.)
- Ductless air conditioning system; woodburning stove for heating
- Garage doors on front and back that can be opened in nice weather to provide cross ventilation
- There is one bathroom in the building. Since students are not on site for long periods, bathroom use will hopefully be minimal.
- Plastic, folding chairs and tables. Tables will be covered with disposable plastic table cloths for additional mindfulness of sanitization beyond just wiping them down. Chairs will be pre-sanitized and post-sanitized for the safety of everyone, using disinfectant (3% peroxide solution and/or Clorox wipes).

### **Schedule:**

- Tuesdays, February 2 – May 2

### **Plan A**

Theory students must be willing to commit to attending a minimum of 10 in-person classes barring any unforeseen changes in the recommendations of the local magistrates, our host site,

a theory family's health condition, or the status of the overall local health recommendations. At this time, no option for "entirely-remote" learning will be offered for Intermediate Theory this fall. Simultaneous Zoom session or FaceTime can be run to allow a student who does not feel comfortable attending in-person classes for that week to attend remotely so as to still keep up with class instruction and interaction.

### Plan B

If we have a need to quarantine due to a positive COVID diagnosis among our class, we will skip one week of classes in-person but conduct class on Zoom for continuity and then resume the following week provided everything is deemed safe. If this is not adequate time for families to assess their personal liability and risk, we will continue on Zoom until it is prudent to meet in person again. We will operate as a "community" of learners who will observe the Golden Rule with regard to our time together.

### **Arrival and Departure Procedures:**

- No parents or siblings on site during class. We will provide a list of places in the surrounding area to wait if parents would like to inquire. This is a "drop-off" model class.
- Students should plan to arrive 10 min prior to the start of class to allow proper time for a more methodical check-in procedure. Theory students should NOT enter any sooner than 12:20 to allow time for JH students to depart at 12:00 followed by sanitization of surfaces.
- When students sign in upon arrival (with their own pen/pencil), they are confirming absence of symptoms, no close contact with COVID-19, etc. (Click here to see the sign in form.) They will also be required to sanitize their hands before entering the class.
- Proper spatial distancing measures will be observed at all times so that masks are not required per the current recommendations. Of course students are welcome and encouraged to wear a mask. We will continue to monitor the most recent thoughtful recommendations on public safety of student populations and adjust requirements as needed.
